- 6. All District GPP Coordinators are required to attend the Orientation Conference on January 18, 2019 (8:00 in the morning) at Pili West District Office, alongside Deped Annex, Cadlan, Pili, Camarines Sur.
- 7. Travel expenses relative to this shall be charged against School MOOE/ Local fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
