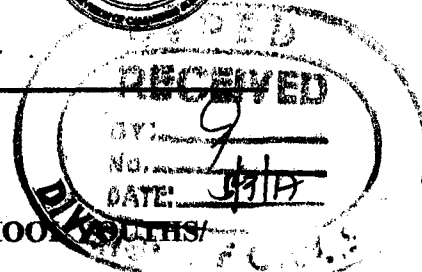

4. Events to be contested, number of contestants and materials needed during the contest.
