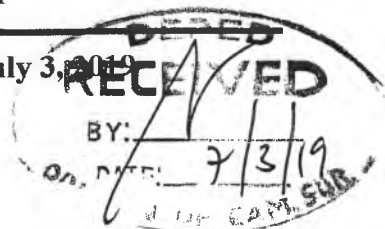



SUBJECT: OK sa Dep Ed One Health Week cum Division Launching on Tobacco Control Program and MPOWER Training on July 22-26, 2019.

1. Pursuant to the Dep Ed Order 28 s. 2018 Policy and Guidelines on Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa Dep Ed), the Division of Camarines Sur, School Health and Nutrition Section will conduct OK sa Dep Ed One Health Week cum Division Launching of Tobacco Control Program and MPOWER training.
2. This activity aims to:
 - a. Provide efficient implementation of the OK sa Dep Ed programs through effective health care services to learners, teachers, non-teaching personnel and the community.
 - b. To ensure health promotion thru Division Launching on Tobacco Control Program and MPOWER training.
 - c. Raise awareness on the Effects of Cigarette Smoking/Vaping and attaining a Smoke Free Environment in the Division of Camarines Sur.
 - d. Provide advocacy campaign on Immunization, WIFA, SBFP, WINS, Deworming and other Dep Ed Health Programs and distribution of the deworming medicine (Albendazole 400 mg. tablet) at the school level in the elementary and secondary learners.
3. The following are the schedules:
 - July 22, 2019-** Division Launching on Tobacco Control Program
- MPOWER Training on Tobacco Control Program
 - July 23, 2019-** Distribution of Deworming Medicine at the School Level
 - July 24, 2019-** School Based Deworming
 - July 25, 2019-** Advocacy Campaign on Immunization, WIFA, SBFP, WINS and other Dep Ed Health Programs
 - July 26, 2019-** Nutrition Month Celebration at the School Level (optional)
4. The Division Launching on Tobacco Control Program will be done on July 22, 2019 right after the flag ceremony with the division non-teaching unit heads and personnel, all division health personnel only as the participants.
5. The participants during the MPOWER training on Tobacco Control Program on July 22, 2019 are the following: All Division Health Personnel, OIC- Chief SGOD, Division Section/ Unit Heads. No registration fee will be charged to the participants.

6. The PSDS of Division of Camarines will have separate schedule of orientation on the Tobacco Control Program.
7. The participants during the MPOWER training are required to **WEAR RED TOP** (red polo shirt, red polo, blouse, etc,) to be worn on July 22, 2019 for the group photo documentation.
8. Attendance is a must, hence no proxy is allowed.
9. The School Based Deworming scheduled on July 24, 2019, will already serve as part of the celebration of the One Health Week of Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (Ok Sa Dep Ed) on the 4th Week of July but school based initiated activities on the said program are highly encouraged to be included during the Nutrition Month Celebration.
10. The District Nurses shall request the School Head in their respective district to designate a teacher for Coordinator on Tobacco Control Program for proper implementation and monitoring of the program at the school level. The District Nurses are expected to conduct orientation on DepEd Order No. 48, s. 2016, Policies and Guidelines on the Comprehensive Tobacco Control Program in their assigned respective districts based on the submitted plan of action. Likewise all the Division Unit Heads are encouraged to conduct orientation on the said Dep Ed Order with their respective units.
11. The Non-teaching personnel in the Division of Camarines, All Elementary and Secondary schools including the Alternative Learning System shall strictly adhere to DepEd Order No. 48, s. 2016, Policies and Guidelines on the Comprehensive Tobacco Control Program .
12. Enclosure #1, is the Scheduled activities for the One Health Week and the Technical Working Group for the Division Launching of Tobacco Control Program and **MPOWER Training**
13. Enclosure #2, contains the Training Matrix for the **MPOWER Training on Tobacco Control Program and Number of Participants in the Cooperating Offices.**
