In consonance with Regional Memorandum No. 73 s. 2019 entitled 16th Regional Alternative Learning System Out-of-School Youths Adults (ALS -OSYs/OSAs) DepEd Alternative Learning System (ALS) of Camarines Sur will hold the Division Out-of-School Youths Adults (OSYs/OSAs) FESTIVAL OF TALENTS AND ALSLYMPIC on July 25, 2019 at Canaman Central School, Canaman, Camarines Sur with the theme "Sa ALS 2.0, Kinabukasan mo'y Sigurado".

- 2. The said activity aims to:
 - a. select division contestants for the 2019 Regional ALS OSYs/OSAs Summer Encampment;
 - b. strengthen self-reliant, dynamic and creative future leaders to become effective, catalysts/agents of change;
 - c. recognize ALS OSYs/OSAs talents and skills
- Participants in this Division ALSlympic and academic contest are out-of-school youths/ adults enrolled in any ALS Learning Programs, Chiefs CID and SGOD, EPS/Division ALS Coordinator, PSDSs, Education Program Specialists- II in ALS, District/School ALS Coordinators, Mobile Teachers, ALS Volunteers, and other interested stakeholders.

Finalization meeting of Tournament Managers, Coaches and Facilitators for the Regional Encampment will be on August 19, 2019 at ALS Office while concentration of winners in sports and academic contest will be on August 20 -22, 2019 at the Freedom Sports Complex, San Jose Pili, Camarines Sur while
- 7. Since August 21, 2019 and August 26, 2019 are regular holidays, this Office authorizes the granting of two-day Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) to non-teaching personnel and Service Credit to teaching personnel pursuant to paragraph 5.3 letter K of Joint Circular No. 2 of the Civil Service Commission and the Department of Budget and Management dated October 4, 2004.
- No registration fee shall be collected from the participant of the congressional district and division events. Transportation, food and other expenses of participants relative to the conduct of the said activity shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- 1. The contest is open to all Alternative Learning System (ALS) Out-of-School Youth and Adult (OSY/OSA) learners registered in LIS 2019 not later than July 31, 2019
- 2. Every learner is allowed to compete in one contest per event only.
- 3. There shall be a contest briefing 15 minutes before contest administration where clarifications could be made, thus contestants must come early.
- 4. Contestant number shall be determined through drawing of lots by district. This will be the number to be used by the district contestant in all events.
- 5. The top three winners will be the only ones awarded.
- 6. Anyone caught in any act of cheating or any form of dishonesty shall automatically be disqualified.
- 7. The decision of the Board of Judges is final.
- 8. Each contestant must secure parent/guardian's permit.
- 9. To ensure the safety of the participants, ALS Canaman shall coordinate with the Local Health Unit, PNP/Barangay Tanod and Rescue Team of LGU Canaman.

SPECIFIC GUIDELINES

I. ESSAY WRITING CONTEST (Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall be eligible to join the contest.
- 2. The essay should revolve around the theme which will be announced during the contest proper.
- 3. The essay must be written on a yellow pad paper using either black or blue pen with one inch margin on all sides. The use of pencil is not allowed.
- 4. The essay shall be written legibly in Filipino.
- 5. Each contestant will be given one hour to complete the essay. He/she shall not be allowed to leave the contest venue once the contest has officially started. Minimum of 300 words and maximum of 500 words is required. All contestants will leave the venue at the same time after one hour.
- 6. Criteria for judging:

Content/Relevance to the theme - 40%
Unity/organization of idea - 40%
Grammar/Semantics - 20%
TOTAL 100%

II. ALS QUIZ (Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall join the contest
- 2. English shall be used as the medium/ language in the conduct of the quiz.
- 3. Each district shall contribute 1question for each category (Easy, Average and Difficult) The quiz master shall draw 15 questions for each category from all the submitted questions as the official questions for the Quiz.



- 4. Questions must be from the modules of learning strands 1 and 2 only. The title of the module where the question comes from must be specified in the submitted question.
- 5. The questions shall be True or False type for Easy; Multiple Choice for the Average Level; and Recall(no option) for difficult questions.
- 6. Point system for every correct answer: Easy one (1) point, Average two (2) points, Difficult three (3) points.
- 7. Each question shall be read twice by the Quiz Master. The contestants shall only be allowed to answer as soon as the Quiz Master signals the time to write the answer.
- 8. Contestants shall be given a period of 5 seconds for Easy questions, 10 seconds for Average questions and 15 seconds for the Difficult ones.
- 9. The contestant shall write his/her answers on a drill board. The contestant shall be allowed to change answer only within the time allotted for a particular question.
- 10. The contestants shall raise their drill boards as soon as the allotted time to answer is over.
- 11. In case of a tie, a tie breaker question shall be asked until a winner is declared.
- 12. The top three contestants who accumulate the most points after 45 questions shall be declared the First, Second and Third placers respectively and will represent our division as a team during the Regional Encampment.

III. SPELLING CONTEST(Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall participate in the contest.
- 2. Twenty five (25) words to be spelled, ten (10) Easy, ten (10) Average and five (5) Difficult will be provided by the Division ALS staff which will be given during the contest proper.
- 3. Easy words shall be given one (1) point, Average words shall be given two (2) points and Difficult words shall be given three (3) points.
- 4. Each contestant shall spell each word on a drill board using chalk.
- 5. Each word shall be read twice by the Quiz-Master. The contestants shall only answer as soon as Quiz Master signals that it is time to write the word.
- 6. Contestants shall be given a maximum of 10 seconds to write the word. Should the contestant decide to change the answer, he/she shall erase or cross the answer with only one horizontal line and the new answer shall be written legibly above the crossed out answer. The contestant shall be allowed to change answer only within the time allotted for a particular question.
- 7. The contestants shall raise their chalks as soon as the allotted time to spell the word is over.
- 8. The facilitators will then collect the drill board, check the spelling/answer of the contestant and record the point/s of those who got the correct spelling of the word.
- 9. The top three contestants who accumulate the most points for all the three(3) categories shall be declared the First, Second and Third placers respectively

IV. Slogan Making Contest (Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall participate in the contest.
- 2. The slogan must have a minimum of five (5) and a maximum of ten (10) words.
- 3. Filipino is the medium to be used. It must be written in ¼ sized white cartolina.
- 4. The Slogan should revolve around the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper.
- 5. The allotted time to prepare the slogan is 30 minutes. All entries shall be submitted to the contest chairman after 30 minutes. However, the contestant may submit his/her slogan earlier than the allotted time.
- 6. A contestant should read and explain the slogan in 5 minutes after ail contestants completed the allotted time.
- 7. The contestant will not be allowed to identify his/her district. He/she will only use the district's number.



8. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

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Content - 30%
Relevance to the theme - 30%
Delivery - 40%
Total 100%

V. On the Spot-Poster-Making Contest (Individual Event)

- 1. One(1) contestant per district shall participate in the contest
- 2. The poster should present/depict the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper.
- 3. The medium for visual artistry shall be Crayola using a ¼ sized white cartolina .
- 4. The allotted time for the contest is one (1) hour. All entries shall be submitted to the contest chairman. Contestant may decide to submit his/her poster on or before the allotted one (1) hour.
- 5. Each poster shall be identified only by the contestant's number.
- 6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

Originality of idea - 40%
Relevance to the theme - 40%
Visual Impact - 20%
Total 100%

VI. ANAGRAM (Individual Event)

- 1. One (1) contestant per district shall participate in the contest.
- 2. There shall be five (5) long words to be provided by the Division ALS Staff which will be given during the contest proper.
- 3. Each contestant shall form as many words as they can from each long word. One syllable word shall be given one (1) point, two syllable words shall be given two (2) points and three or more syllable word shall be given three (3) points.
- 4. The allotted time for the contest is five (5) minutes per word.
- 5. The winner will be the contestant with the highest points.

VII. SEARCH FOR MR. AND MS. ALS CAMARINES SUR 2019

- 1. Each Congressional district must have one (1) pair of contestants for the pageant.
- 2. Registration Form will be filled-out for formal introduction during the search.
- 3. The learner contestants shall wear ALS T-shirt and denim shorts with additional modification while the implementer contestants shall wear pants and T-shirt.
- 4. The contestant will compete only for the production number and Question & Answer portion.
- 5. The questions for the Question & Answer will be provided by each district. Each district will submit the question to the management one hour before the pageant begins for screening. It must be written on a short bond paper, double spaced.
- 6. Judging shall be based on the following criteria:

- 1. The ALSLympics shall consist of an Individual Event (scrabble, chess, runs and badminton -girl and boy), Mixed double for Badminton and Team Events (400 meter Relay, Sepak Takraw, Futsal, Mixed Volleyball and Basketball)
- 2. The events will be managed by Dr. Edgar A. Tabagan and Mr. Pedro C. Peñaflor who will provide the mechanics and coordinate to the supply office for the materials/equipments that will be used.
