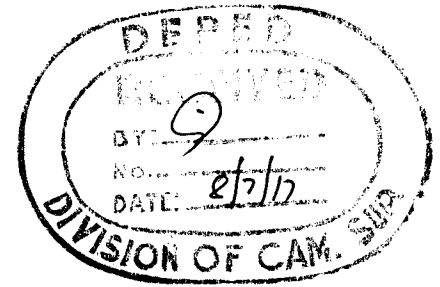

SUBJECT: **REORIENTATION OF PSDSs ON BARANGAY LITERACY WORKERS (BLW)
PROGRAM and OTHER ALS PROGRAMS and PROJECTS**

1. In line with the implementation of the rationalization program of the government, the delineation of duties and responsibilities of PSDS, EPS and Implementers must be properly communicated to the field for the improvement of delivery along Quality, Efficiency and Access as Key Performance Indicators of our department.
2. Thus, the Curriculum Implementation Division, Alternative Learning System unit will be having a Reorientation of PSDSs on ALS Programs and Projects on August 10, 2017, 8:00 to 12:00 PM at the Schools Division Office of CamSur Conference Hall, San Jose, Pili, Camarines Sur.
3. The participants to this activity are the Schools Division Superintendent, Asst. Schools Division Superintendent (In-Charge of ALS), Chief of CID, Public Schools District Supervisors (Elementary and Secondary), Education Program Specialists II (CID) and Australian Volunteers for International Development (AVID).
4. The objectives of this conference are as follows:
 - a. To revisit the Organizational Structure of ALS related to the roles and functions based on the Rationalization Program of DepEd
 - b. To orient the participants about the implementation of programs and projects of ALS including monitoring and evaluation.
 - c. To sustain the implementation of one of the support programs of SDO Camarines Sur, the Barangay Literacy Worker through constant updates on the accomplishments and partnerships made by implementers to the LGU and other stakeholders.
5. The travel and incidental expenses shall be chargeable against the school/division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
