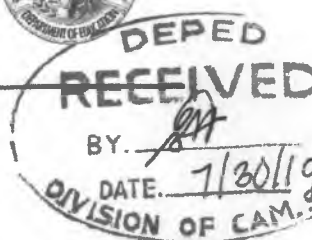

**PARTICIPATION IN BSP BASIC TRAINING COURSES OF TEACHERS, NON- TEACHING PERSONNEL AND DEPED OFFICIALS (with CPD Units) SY: 2019-2020**

1. Relative to DepEd Order no. 76, s. 2012 re: Revitalizing Boy Scouting in Schools Nationwide, the **Schools Division Office (SDO) Camarines Sur** announces the conduct of Basic Training Courses for Unit Leaders such as Kawan/ Troop/ Assistant Unit Leaders and Outfit/Assistant Advisors (with CPD Units) in the Division of Camarines Sur for SY: 2019-2020. For Buhi District it will be on August 02-04, 2019 at Sta. Justina West Central School, Buhi, Camarines Sur.

2. Subsequent Basic Training Course (BTC), Advanced Training Course (ATC), Course for Managers of Training (CMT), Courses for Managers of Leaders (CML) and Training of Leaders of Adults (LOA) for SY 2019-2020 shall be announced through a BSP Council Memo duly concurred by the office of the Schools Division Superintendent.

3. The requirements for participation: Kawan/ Troop/ Assistant Unit Leaders and Outfit/Assistant Advisors who are currently registered with the BSP, 18 but not over 55 years old, of good moral character and with institutional permit. The Alternative Learning System (ALS) DALSC, Mobile Teachers, and Volunteers enthusiasts who meet the requirements are also encouraged to join the said activity.


It is expected that participants shall help their school through scouting to strengthen the good conduct and discipline as well as to improve the basic life skills, among others, of pupils and students.

4. Registration Fee and expenses which may be incurred in connection with this activity can be charged against SEF/BSP fund/ or any other available local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. Service Credits shall be granted to teachers for services rendered during weekends and holidays and Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) for school/district/division officials per DEPED Order No. 53, series 2003 and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, series 2004, respectively.

2. Requirements for Participation: All Unit Leaders who are currently registered with the BSP, 18 but not over 55 years old, of good moral character and with institutional permit. For all those who are interested to serve as Course Staff please attend the BTC Staff Meeting on Saturday, **20 July 2019** at 9:00 A.M. at the Council Office, Panganiban Drive, and Naga City.
3. A Registration Fee of **Two Thousand Pesos** (Php2,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover costs of meals/snacks for the duration, certificate, KL/TL/OA Manual, T-shirt with print, handouts, program and other administrative needs.

  - 5.4 Nobody shall be allowed to leave the camp without the prior permission/approval of the respective Course Leader.
  - 5.5 Drinking of any liquor/spirited wine and Gambling of any form is strictly prohibited in camp.
  - 5.6 The Scout Law is the Law of the Camp.
