2. The 2019-2020 Technolympics is an integral activity of the Tech. Voc schools, Regular/Senior High School and Elementary schools. It provides students and pupils with practical experiences, technical know-how and opportunities in Home Economics, Agricultural Technology, Industrial Arts, Entrepreneurship and ICT Integration. It also aims to develop their leadership personal skills and building wholesome character to strengthen national competitiveness and productiveness

3. The specific guidelines for each skills exhibition, the official participants for the said event as well as the members of the Division Management Team by component/level are provided in the following enclosures:

- 4. The host school shall collect a registration fee of one hundred and fifty pesos (P150.00) from each participant to cover the operational expenses of the activity. This fund shall be solicited from the PTA fund and other local funds. There must be three contestants for each skills or event (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners).
- 5. The participants, working committees and other personnel who are directly involved in this training shall be entitled to Service Credits and other Compensatory Overtime Credits accordingly as per existing rules and regulations.
- 6. A conference of all Host principal, contest administrators in the different areas of specialization is scheduled on September 13, 2019 at 8:00-12:00 P.M. at Camaligan National High School for secondary and 1:00 P.M. for elementary at Camaligan Central School. Contest Administrators are required to bring the guidelines for each contest package and the list of judges per event.
- 7. Travel and other related expenses incurred in this activity shall be charged against School MOOE and other funds subject to usual accounting, rules and regulations.
