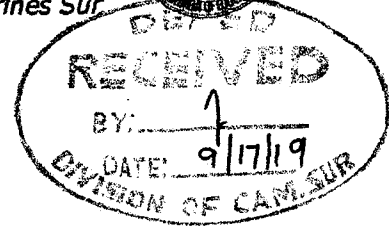

**SUBJECT: 2019 DIVISION PATIRIBAYAN IN EDUKASYON SA
PAGPAPAKATAO (Secondary Level)**

1. In view of the Division's objective to cultivate the talents and skills of students in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, this year's Division Patiribayan in EsP is set on **November 15, 2019** (Friday) at **BAAO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL**, Baao, Camarines Sur. The theme is **"PAGPAPAKATAO AT MODERNONG TEKNOLOHIYA: HAMON SA MAKABAGONG HENERASYON."**

2. Participants in this activity are the winning students/teams and coaches in every event in the School Level which is scheduled from September 23, 2019 to November 14, 2019.

3. Events to be contested are as follows:

4. A registration fee of one hundred pesos (P100.00) will be charged to each participant and coach in Poster Making, Slogan Contest and Reflective Writing, and three hundred pesos (P300.00) for team events which includes Tagis Talino, Jingle Writing and Short Film Making. This is to cover and defray the operational expenses of the said activity. Coaches with more than one entry will register per event.

5. Travel expenses of teacher coaches, different committees, event facilitators, Board of Judges shall be charged against School MOOE/Local Funds, while travel expenses and registration fee of student participants and registration fee of coaches shall be charged to PTA Funds/SEF/ Organization Funds/School Club Funds and other sources of funds subject to its availability and to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Participants	<p>A. Poster Making Contest – a student from any grade level (Grade 7 to 10) who won in the same event in the School Level. Only one contestant will be allowed to represent each school.</p> <p>B. Slogan Making Contest – a student from any grade level (Grade 7 to 10) who won in the same event in the School Level. Only one contestant will be allowed to represent each school.</p> <p>C. Reflective Writing</p> <p>1. Category A – a Grade 7 or Grade 8 student who won in the same event in the School Level. Only one contestant will be allowed to represent each school.</p> <p>2. Category B – a Grade 9 or Grade 10 student who won in the same event in the School Level. Only one contestant will be allowed to represent each school.</p> <p>D. Tagis Talino – a team of four (4) members composed of all Grade Level (Grade 7 to 10) as long as there is no duplication of contestants in a particular grade level. Each grade level should be represented.</p> <p>E. Jingle Writing – a team of four (4) members composed of any Grade Level (Grade 7 to 10) or may belong to the same grade level or mixed contestants from any grade level.</p> <p>F. Short Film Making – open to all Grade 7-10 students and with no limit on the number of characters. (actors/actresses)</p>
Levels of Competition	<p>School Level - anytime from September 23 to November 14, 2019 Division Level - November 15, 2019</p>
Contest Mechanics	<p>A. Poster Making Contest</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The contest is open to a student from any Grade Level (Grade 7 to 10) Two(2) hours is allotted for the poster making activity. Each contestant shall bring his/her own materials, a ¼ illustration board, a set of oil pastel and pencil. Letterings and borders are not allowed as part of the presentation. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable. <p>B. Slogan Making Contest</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The contest is open to a student from any Grade Level (Grade 7 to 10) One (1) hour is allotted for the slogan making activity. Each contestant shall bring his/her own materials, a ½ white cartolina, a black broad pentel pen, ruler and pencil. The medium for slogan making is Filipino and should consist of 16 words. (All two or three-letter words like at, ay, sa, ng, may, ang, mga, etc. are included in the counting of words) All lettering styles and borders, though part of the presentation shall have no bearing on the rating. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable. <p>C. Reflective Writing (Medium of expression is in Filipino for both categories) Category A</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The contest is open to Grade 7 and Grade 8 students. The contestants will be asked to reflect on a Biblical verse using the skills learned in EsP classes. One and a half hour (1 & ½) is allotted for the reflection writing activity. Each contestant is allowed to write his/her reflection

Category B

- The contest is open to **Grade 9 and Grade 10 students.**
- The contestants will be asked to reflect on a Biblical verse using the skills learned in EsP classes.
- One and a half hour (1 & ½) is allotted for the reflection writing activity.
- Each contestant is allowed to write his/her reflection in a yellow paper/yellow pad with a minimum of one(1) page and a maximum of two(2) pages and no writings at the back.
- The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

D.Tagis Talino

- The contest is a team event. Each team is composed of four(4) students from Grade 7 to Grade 10. (must be a team of one Grade 7, one Grade 8, one Grade 9 and one Grade 10 student)
- Each team will submit one(1) question. Questions shall be in multiple choice type. This may include questions with WHAT,WHO,WHERE,WHEN, WHY and HOW. Questions that trigger higher order thinking skills (HOTS) are allowed to develop critical thinking.
- Questions shall be printed in a ½ crosswise long size bond paper. Answer should be found on the lower right portion of the paper. The name of the school should be written at the back of the questionnaire.
- Questions will be submitted to the in-charge 30 minutes before the time of the quiz bee with the presence of all coaches. It should be placed in a white long envelope, sealed and will be opened only at the start of the quiz bee.
- The questions shall be taken only from the modules or prescribed Learning Materials in Grade 7 to 10. A question found to be vague shall be disqualified. Reference and page where the question was taken should be indicated in the question item.
- Each question has a corresponding point: one point for every item.
- Each team should bring a yellow pad where they shall write their answers.
- After reading all questions, designated committee members will check the papers to determine the Top 10. In case of tie, another set of questions will be given to the contestants to determine the winner.
- The question should be read twice by the quizmaster.
- Time allotment for every question is 20 seconds.
- There will be one (1) coach for Tagis Talino.

E. Jingle Writing

- The contest is a team event. Each team is composed of four(4) students from any grade level. (Grade 7 to Grade 10). They may belong to the same grade level or mixed contestants from any grade level.
- The team shall sing a jingle composition in Filipino with 3 to 4 minutes running time. Accompaniment may be recorded in a CD, flash drive or any other electronic means. Live accompaniment is allowed and they are excluded from the number of participants.

F.Short Film Making

- The contest is a team event. A short story depicting Filipino values shall be filmed through any electronic means with the EsP students as the actors and actresses.
- There is no limit on the number of characters.
- The coach may serve as the director of the short film.
- A minimum of ten(10) minutes and a maximum of fifteen(15) minutes showing time will be allotted for every entry in the short film.
- The official medium of communication in the short film is Filipino. The cast of characters (actors and actresses) are allowed to use *Rinol or English* if there are some technical terms which are difficult

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The entire cast and staff of the short film may not report to the contest venue. The participating school may send only one(1) cast or a maximum of four(4) cast/staff and one(1) coach to the contest venue for purposes of presentation of the film.
