This is to cover and defray the operational expenses of the said activity. Coaches with more than one entry will register per event.

5. Travel expenses of teacher coaches, different committees, event facilitators, Board of Judges shall be charged against School MOOE/Local Funds, while travel expenses and registration fee of student participants and registration fee of coaches shall be charged to PTA Funds/SEF/ Organization Funds/School Club Funds and other sources of funds subject to its availability and to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

		questionnaire.
	•	Questions will be submitted to the in-charge 30 minutes before
		the time of the quiz bee with the presence of all coaches. It should
		be placed in a white long envelope, sealed and will be opened only
		at the start of the quiz bee.
	•	The questions shall be taken only from the modules or prescribed
		Learning Materials in Grade 7 to 10. A question found to be vague
		shall be disqualified. Reference and page where the question was
		taken should be indicated in the question item.
		Each question has a corresponding point: one point for every item.
		Each team should bring a yellow pad where they shall write their
		answers.
