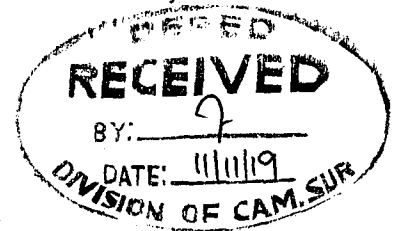

RED CROSS YOUTH CAMP 2019

1. The Philippine Red Cross (PRC) celebrates the month of November as the Red Cross Youth (RCY) month. It is a month-long celebration that recognizes the enthusiasm and eagerness of the Youth Volunteers in rendering help to the community and showing support to the PRC's campaign in alleviating human suffering. This 2019, the Red Cross Youth is now celebrating its 102 years in service.
2. In line with this, the Camarines Sur- Red Youth Council is having a **RED CROSS YOUTH CAMP 2019 on November 22-24, 2019 at Pacol Sports Complex**, with the theme: RCY GRIT: **"Greatness, Resiliency, Inclusivity and Tenacity for Humanitarian Action"** is an opportunity for all the leaders and youth to enhance and share their skills and talents within the organization.
3. The participants in this activity are coming from secondary schools which shall include maximum of 10 students from each school, 1 RCY Coordinator and 1 Chaperon.
4. Attached in this memorandum are the Red Cross Youth Camp Guidelines, Parent Permission Form, Registration Form and List of schools who attended the Leadership Development Program and have an existing RCY Council.
5. Service Credits shall be granted to teachers as per **DepEd Order 53, s. 2003** and **Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) as per CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s 2004** for services rendered during weekends and holidays.
6. The schools must ensure compliance with the requirements of **DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 (OFF-CAMPUS ACTIVITIES)** especially on Child protection, safety and security protocols, among others.



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7. Registration fee, travelling expenses, meals and insurance of the students shall be charged to the PTA FUND/SSG FUND. While, expenses incurred by the Teachers shall be charged against School MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.

I. OBJECTIVES

1. Celebrate the Red Cross Youth Month in a meaningful and engaging activities
2. Engage the members in exciting and strenuous activities of the camp that will enhance their tenacity
3. Practice the value of leadership, friendship and volunteerism among the members
4. Show to the members the essence of responsibility, teamwork and decision-making

II. REQUIREMENTS

1. Parental Permit/Waiver
2. Medical Certificate
3. Pre-Registration Form
4. Registration Fee

III. QUALIFICATIONS

- 1) be a bona fide member of Philippine Red Cross;
- 2) have undergone Leadership Training Program
- 3) MAAB (Membership Accidental Assistance Benefits)
- 4) be 15 years old and above;
- 5) have a good moral character;
- 6) be physically, mentally and emotionally fit

IV. GENERAL GUIDELINES:

1. Each existing council can send many as they can while the Non- RCY Council can send a **minimum of five (5) and maximum of ten (10) participants**
2. The Youth Camp is a three-day activity scheduled on **November 22-24, 2019 at Pacol Sports Complex, Naga City.**
3. The Campers will be divided into groups, which will be composed of members from different councils.
4. The Campers will be accompanied by the following:
 - Chapter Staff and Volunteers
 - Safety Services Volunteers
 - Chapter Youth Council Officers
 - Council Advisers/Moderators
5. Each council will set-up their tents and secures their personal belongings.
6. Each council will prepare their own food good for 3 days.



7. We would like also to impose the practice of CLAYGO and reducing the use of plastic during the camp. **(Provide your own trash bag separating biodegradable and non-biodegradable)**
8. Materials needed for every activity will be provided by the organizer.
9. Each council must bring their **council banner**.
10. Each Camper is asked to prepare the following for himself:
 - Flashlight
 - Tent
 - Beddings
 - Eating Utensils
 - Personal Medicine/s
 - Clothes for 3 days

	Shirt Color
Day 1	Red Shirt with the Red Cross Logo and if not available can use any red shirt
Day 2	Blue
Day 3	Morning- Black Afternoon- Camp Shirt

- Hygiene Kit
 - Para cord
 - Food or other materials/equipment assigned by the adviser
11. At camp, there will be specific areas assigned for comfort rooms and cooking areas.
 12. A medical station and a standby vehicle will be ready in case of an emergency.
 13. Each participant should bring pen and small notebook.
 14. There will be series of challenges and activities that each group should accomplish.
 15. The groups are required to assess possible needs of members of the group and ensure discipline at all times.
 16. Observe proper decorum at all times.
 17. Each Council is highly encouraged to offer (eggs, fruits, etc) for the mass.
 18. **If the participant doesn't have MAAB they can still register on the first day of the camp (Php 60.00 for classic membership)**
 19. Problems encountered by participant/individual should be directly reported to the organizers.
 20. Each council should prepare one presentation.
 21. There should be separate sleeping quarters for ladies and gentlemen.

REGISTRATION FEE

Each participant shall pay a Registration Fee of **P250.00** (Two-hundred fifty pesos only). The registration fee will cover the expenses for the camp (materials, ID, certificate, token, food for the speaker and T-shirt).

Deadline of payment: November 13, 2019 together with the pre-registration sheet.
