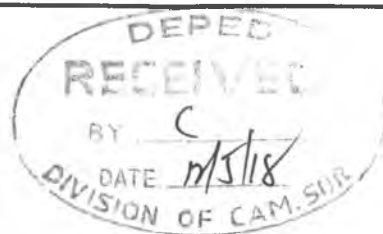

Subject: Extension of School-Based Feeding Days (Saturdays, Sundays, and until December 18, 2018)

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 39, series 2017 re: Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of School-Based Feeding Program for School-Years 2017-2022 specifically No. VII, letters A and B, and due to the pronouncement in DepEd Order 49, series 2018 regarding Christmas Break, this Division shall conduct a School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) during Saturdays, Sundays starting December 8, 2018 and extended until December 18, 2018 to maximize the utilization of funds and to complete the 120 feeding days.
 2. Identified recipients of the School-Based Feeding Program for School-Year 2017-2018, teachers (members of the core group, SBFP Coordinator, disbursing officer), parents, and school heads are the target participants of this activity.
 3. Previously issued policies on menu of the day, work and financial plan, disbursement of funds, and liquidation of downloaded SBFP funds shall be observed accordingly.
 4. Teachers (Members of the Core Group, SBFP Coordinator, Disbursing Officer) who are directly involved in the implementation of the program shall be entitled to service credits during Saturdays, Sundays, and on December 17 and 18, 2018 pursuant to DepEd Order 53, series 2003 and Division Unnumbered Memorandum dated November 10, 2018.
 5. DepED nonteaching personnel shall be entitled to Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) pursuant to par. 5.3 letter k of Joint Circular No.2 of the CSC and DBM dated October 4, 2014 for services rendered during Saturdays and Sundays.
 6. School Health Personnel in-charge of the program and Public Schools District Supervisors are enjoined to monitor the implementation of this activity.
 7. Report of compliance shall form part of the Terminal Report to be submitted to the Office.
